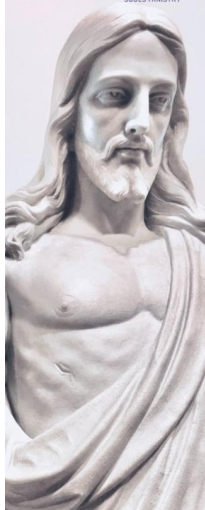
## DIOCESAN SACRED HEART PILGRIMAGE CHALLENGE
